That on November 27, 1917, and for some time prior thereto, he was the active President of the Planters National Bank, a corporation organized under the Federal Banking Act, with its principal place of business in Tulsa, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma; that he was present at an adjourned meeting of the shareholders of the said Planters National Bank, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, held at its banking rooms in Tulsa, Oklahoma, on Tuesday, November 27, 1917, at 4:00 o'clock P. M.; that at said meeting more than two-thirds of the capital stock of said Bank was represented in person or by proxy, and that at said meeting the following resolution was unanimously adopted by said shareholders, to-wit:

" RESOLVED: That the Planters National Bank be placed in voluntary liquidation under the provisions of Sections 5220 and 5221, United States Revised Statutes, to take effect November 28, 1917, and that W. A. Brownlee be appointed Liquidating Agent or Liquidation Committee of said Bank."

Affiant further states that the above words and figures are one and the same as used in the original resolution, and that the above resolution is a true and exact copy of said resolution as it now appears of record in the minutes of the said Planters National Bank.
