Whereas, Frank Haikey a citizen of the Creek Nation was allotted the following described land, to-wit;

Southeast Quarter (SE4) of Northwest Quarter (NW4) of Section Twenty (20), Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Fourteen (14) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing 40 acres, more or less, located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

Now, Therefore, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908, ( Public No. 140) and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the restrictions from said above described land, such removal of restrictions to become effective only and simultaneously with the execution of the deed by said allottee to the purchaser after said land has been sold in compliance with the directions of the Secretary of the Interior.
