

line of the present right of way for parks and boulevard or Riverside Drive  
along by the Arkansas River;

and each and all of said portions and strips of land, be and the same are hereby vacated and  
abandoned forever as portions of said Detroit Avenue and said Eighteenth Street, subject only  
to the provisions of the Charter of the said City of Tulsa.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provi-  
sions of this ordinance, in so far as such conflicts exist, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health and  
safety, by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval  
and publication.

PASSED, and the emergency clause ruled upon separately and approved this 29th day  
of March, 1918.
