ORDINANCE NO. 2080.

An Ordinance vacating the alley running East and West in Block 10, Oakdale Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the official plat thereof, with certain reservations; and declaring an emergency.

THEREAS, a petition signed by a majority of the property owners owning property in the Block herein mentioned, has been presented to the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, asking that the alley therein described be vacated and abandoned as a public alley,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TULSA,
OKLAHOMA: OK as to Griggs

description E.E. SECTION 1: That the alley extending East and West in Block Ten (10) of Oakdale Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the official plat thereof, lying between Fourteenth and. Fifteenth Streets and between Detroit Avenue and the Midland Valley Railroad Company right of way in the City of Tulsa, be, and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned as a public alley of said city.

PROVIDED, however, that the City of Tulsa hereby reserves and shall retain forever, the right to construct, reconstruct, repair, maintain and operate sanitary sewers and other appurtenances thereto appertaining, now located or maintained in said alley, or which of necessity should be constructed or maintained in said alley, with the right of ingress and egress over said premises for the purposes above indicated, and for said purposes, four (4) feet on each side of the center line of said alley is hereby maintained by the City of Tulsa, upon which said City of Tulsa may allow public service corporations, companies, individuals or itself to construct, maintain and operate facilities for public utilities, including poles, wires, pipes, conduits and other necessary accessories; and,

Provided further, that four (4) feet on each side of the center line of said alley shall be construed to mean sufficient space near the menter of said alley for the purposes above specified;

And, provided further, that the above vacation is made subject to the conditions and provisions of paragraph 11 of Section 6 of Article II of the Charter of the City of Tulsa.
