## ASSIGNMENT OF JUDGMENTS.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, Julia E. Asbridge, the judgment creditor mentioned in the judgments hereinafter set out, for a valuable consideration, to-wit: the payment in full of all of the said judgments hereinafter referred to, together with interest and court costs due thereon, and in connection therewith, and which amounts have this day been received by me from E. E. Friend, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I do hereby, and by these presents, set over, assign, sell, transfer and deliver unto the said E. E. Friend, all of my right, title and interests in and to the following judgments, to-wit:

1st: A certain judgment in cause No. 10, 132 in the District Court of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, in the case of Julia E. Asbridge, plaintiff V. Tulsa Auto Livery Company, a corporation, John R. Boling and Dottie R. Boling, are defendants, and which judgment is against the defendant, Dottie R. Boling; said judgment being dated December 3, 1920, and being for the sum of \$20,000.00 and interest at 6% per annum and all costs thereof.

2nd: A certain judgment rendered in the Supreme Court of the State of Oklahoma in favor of Julia E. Asbridge and against Dottie R. Boling, Miss Hazel Wills, John R. Boling and M. J. McNulty, Jr., dated the 31st day of January, 1922 and which judgment affirmed the judgment of the District Court of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, hereinbefore mentioned, and which judgment by proper mandate has also become a judgment in the said cause No. 10, 132 in the District Court of Tulsa County, hereinbefore referred to, and which mandate and judgment was filed in the District Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on the 1 day of February, 1922.
