SPĒCIAL SEWER CONTRACTI.

THIS ACREEMENT, made and entered into this the 26 day of Sept. 1924, by and between the CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA, party of the first part, and Mrs Josephine Sieber of Tulsa County, Okla. State, part of the second part; WITNESSETH:

For and in consideration of the use of and connection with the sewer system in SEWER DISTRICT NO. 136 of said City of Tulsa, and the covenants and agreements herein contained, the said part of the second part do hereby covenant and agree with the said City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, as follows, to-wit:

That the said part of the second part the fee owner of the following property covered by this contract, to-wit: Lot fourteen (14) block one (1) Englewood Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

That the said part of the second part is hereby authorized and permitted to construct, connect with and make use of the sewer in SEWER DISTRICT NO 136 of the City of Tulsa, upon the said part of the second part paying the entire cost of such sewer construction, connection and use, and in addition paying to the said City of Tulsa, the sum of Five (5%) per centum of the cost of such construction, connection and use, as an engineering fee for the supervision of such construction, connection and use.
