EASEMENT FOR HIGHWAY PURPOSES.

The undersigned, owner of the South-west Quarter of Section 15, Township 19 North, Range 13 East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, hereby grants to the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, for and in consideration of the sum of \$100, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, a perpetual easement for public highway purposes, upon, over and across the following described lands.

" AN EASEMENT is granted Tulsa County over that part of South-West (1/4) Quarter of Section 15, Township 19 North, Range 13 East, lying between the northerly right of way line of the M. K. T. Railway and a line described as beginning at a point 694.33 feet east of the Southwest corner of said section, and running thence, North 65 degrees West a distance of 654.05 feet to the point of a curve to the right with a central angle of 65 degrees and a radius of 131.97 feet; thence to the right around the arc of said curve to a point that is 25 feet east of a point that is 396.07 feet north of the south line of said Section 15; thence west 25 feet to the said Section line; thence south along the section line to the northerly right of way line of the M. K. T. Railway"

And the said Tulsa County shall have the right to construct, maintain and forever use as a public highway, over and across upon and through the said above described lands, including the cutting of ditches and channel changes as may be necessary in the construction of said highways.
