placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, the said Mortgagor, their heirs, legal representatives, successors and assigns, shall pay reasonable attorney's fees, and any expense incurred in procuring a supplemental abstract of title to said premises, with interest on such sums at the rate of ten per centum per annum, the same to be taxed as part of the cost of the case; for the benefit of the plaintiff or complainant, and the same shall be a lien on the premises hereby mortgaged, and shall be due and payable when action is commenced, or when said principal note is placed in the Mands of an attorney for collection; and for the consideration above mentioned the said Mortgagor hereby expressly waives the appraisement of said real estate and all benefits of the homestead and stay laws of said State.

TWELFTH If any action or proceeding be commenced (except an action to foreclose this mortgage or to collect the debt secured thereby) to which action or proceeding
