All buildings, plants, factories, refineries, work shops, offices, warehouses, pipe lines, rolling equipment, structures, improvements, fixtures, appliances, machinery, derricks, drilling apparatus, tools, parts, implements, equipment and apparatus owned by the Indiahoma sefining Company at the time of its adjudication in bankriptcy by the District Court of the United States for the Eastern Division of the Eastern Judicial District of Missouri, or in or to which the Indiahoma Refining Company at the time of its said adjudication had any right or claim to the extent of such ownership, right or claim, except as the same is-herein elsewhere specifically described.
