RENT ASSIGNMENT.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to us in hand paid, and of other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we Guy W. Settle and Grace H. Settle, his wife, of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, do hereby assign and set over to M. Hughes, Trustee for the Central Savings & Loan Association of Marshall, Mo., all rentals, profits, and emoluments accruing to or arising from the following real estate situated in the County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma to-wit:

And, the said M.
