WITNESSETH: That the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, and other good and valuate considerations, in hand paid, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and further in consideration of the following covenants, which are a condition of this deed and to which party of the second part, her heirs, executors, or administrators, by accepting the deed, consent and agree to keep inviolate, to-wit:
