do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said O. W. Boone & Belle Boone
and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in
the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

The North Seventy-five (75) Feet of Lot Three (3) in Block One Hundred & Forty-eight (148)
according to the original plat of the town of Tulsa, Creek National Indian Territory, as approved by the
Secretary of Interior April 11th, 1902.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated October 20th 1902
and recorded October 22nd 1902 in Book C2 at Page 89 of the records of the Muskogee Recording Station
O. W. Boone & Belle Boone his wife conveying said real estate to
Mrs. L. M. Poe to secure the pay-
