for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by Anna B. Boone & O. C. Boone  
do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Anna B. Boone & O. C. Boone  
and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in  
the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

the North Twenty-five (25) feet of Lot Three (3) in Block One Hundred Twenty-eight (128) according to the original plat of the town of Tulsa, Creek Nation, Indian Territory, as approved by the Secretary of Interior April 15th, 1902.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated June 18th 1902  
and filed June 15th 1902 in Book 4882 at Page 11 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by  
Anna B. Boone & O. C. Boone her heirs, conveying said real estate to  
Janie Koenig to secure the pay-  
ment of this certain note therein named, the same having been fully paid.
