

DEED OF RELEASE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by E. L. Martinis & Jennie H. Martinis
do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said E. L. Martinis & Jennie H. Martinis
and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in
the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

That part of Lot Four (4) in Block One Hundred Forty six (146) in the town of Tulsa, I. T. according to the
official plat and survey thereof, having a frontage of fifty (50) feet on South Cincinnati Ave. and a depth of
One Hundred & Forty (140) feet to the alley, the alley line in rear of said lot with a uniform width of fifty (50) feet,
line parallel to and adjoining East 6th Street. This being a tract of ground commonly described as the South
One half (1/2) of Lot Four (4) in Block One Hundred & Forty six (146)

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of mortgage dated October 1st, 1906
and recorded December 5th, 1906 in Book 3 at Page 108 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by
