KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT James C. Graves

for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by Richard W. DeFord  
do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Richard W. DeFord

the Eight Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

the South one half (1/2) of lot number five (5) in block one-hundred and sixty one (161) in the town of Tulsa,
