do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said George West

the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot six (6) and seven (7) and nine (9) and all of Lot eight (8) except the south six feet thereof, all in Block Four (4) in Lurley Addition to the town of Lurley, I.T. according to the recorded Plat thereof

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated February 14 1906
and recorded Feb. 17th 1906 in Book at Page of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by
