DEED OF RELEASE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT I, William W. Busby, duly appointed administrator of the estate of Calliway Callicott deceased for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by Jacob D. Remeau do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Jacob D. Remeau and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in County the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot three (3) and north fifty (50) feet of Lot four (4) Block one hundred and two (102) according to the approved Government plat of the town of Tulsa.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated December 21st 1904 and recorded January 5 1905 in Book at Page of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by Jacob D. Remeau and Delia Remeau conveying said real estate to Calliway Callicott to secure the payment of one certain note of \$1100.00 therein named, the same having been fully paid.
