DEED OF RELEASE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT Bank of Commerce of Tulsa, I.T. by J. H. Mc Birney President and
J. P. Mc Birney, Cashier

for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by Arthur A. Kemp

do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Arthur A. Kemp and
his wife Ada Kemp and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in

the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South Forty (40) feet of Lot One (1) and the North Five (5) feet
of Lot Two (2) in Block One Hundred, one (101) in the town of Tulsa Indian
Territory. Also Lot Two (2) in Block One Hundred Thirty Three (133) in
the town of Tulsa, I.T. according to the United States survey and plat
thereof.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated July 29, 1905
and recorded July 31, 1905 in Book 0 at Page 105 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by

Arthur A. Kemp and Ada Kemp, his wife conveying said real estate to
Bank of Commerce, of Tulsa, I.T. to secure the pay-
ment of one certain note therein named, the same having been fully paid.
