DEED OF RELEASE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT R. F. Powell

for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by

Nellie A. Chesley and Frank Chesley

do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said

Nellie A. Chesley and Frank Chesley

and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in

the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

a plat of ground 50 x 100 feet fronting on Third Street and being a part of lot 4 block 101 and more particularly described as follows: beginning at a point 40 feet westerly from the southeasterly corner of said lot 4 and on the southerly line of said lot 4, thence running northerly 100 feet to the easterly line of said lot 4, thence 100 feet to the northerly line of said lot 4, thence southerly and parallel to westerly line of said lot 4, 50 feet to the southerly line of said lot, thence easterly along the southerly line 50 feet to point of beginning according to the recorded plat of said town of Tulsa Indian Territory

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Trust dated 14th day of May 1906

and recorded May 15th 1906 in Book 12 at Page 48 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by

Nellie A. Chesley and Frank Chesley conveying said real estate to R. F. Powell to secure the pay-

ment of the certain promissory notes therein named, the same having been fully paid.
