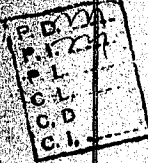


DEED OF RELEASE.

 and recorded August 7, 1906 in Book 8 at Page 613 of the records of the 28th Recording District of the Indian Territory, by
Nicholas J. Guber conveying said real estate to
J. W. Holloway to secure the pay-
 ment of one certain promissory therein named, the same having been fully paid.
