KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT we Lon R. Stansberry and John N. Day

for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by R. M. Stone, Helen Stone and A. B. Stone do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said R. M. Stone and Helen Stone his wife and A. B. Stone widower and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot four (4) in Block three (3) in the Stansberry's Addition to the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory and according to the recorded plat thereof with all the improvements thereon

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated January 30 1907 and recorded Feb. 2 1907 in Book - at Page - of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by R. M. Stone, Helen Stone and A. B. Stone conveying said real estate to Lon R. Stansberry and John N. Day to secure the payment of one certain \$500 note therein named, the same having been fully paid.
