Thomas, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Melissa E. Thomas and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in Crab Nation, Western the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South Seventy-five (75) feet of Lot number Four (4) in Block number One Hundred Seventy-five (175) in the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated August 1, 1904 and recorded August 13, 1904 in Book L at Page 297 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, wherein John Canaway and Ida Canaway, his wife conveyed conveying said real estate to Katherine J. Molitor to secure the payment of one certain note for \$100.00 therein named, the same having been fully paid.
