for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by D. C. Rase, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said D. C. Rase, and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in Beck's Station, Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of Lot No Seven (7) and the East half (1/2) of Lot No six (6) in Block No One hundred sixty eight (168) in the town of Tulsa according to the official Plat and Survey thereof.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated July 20 1907 and recorded July 26 1907 in Book L at Page 423 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by A. F. Blackburn conveying said real estate to A. F. Blackburn to secure the payment of one certain note therein named, the same having been fully paid.
