This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of mortgage with dated November 8th, 1906  
190 - - and recorded November 12th 1906 in Book 4 at Page 567 of the records of the Western Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by

John H. Middleton to secure the pay-
