

DEED OF RELEASE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

The North Fifty (50) feet of Lot No. Five (5) in Block No. One hundred twenty-five (125) in the Town of Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the Official Plat and Survey thereof

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated Oct. 3rd 1906 and recorded October 3rd 1906 in Book 4th at Page 4th of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by J.
