This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated September 4 1906 and recorded September 4th 1906 in Book 2 at Page 47 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by Mary E. Lear and her husband John W. Lear conveying said real estate to J. L. Stigleman to secure the payment of their certain notes therein named, the same having been fully paid.
