the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot 4 & 5 in Block 31 in Tulsa I.T. said lots are 82 x 300 feet on the south side of Block 31 also two dwelling houses on 3 room each and all fences & other improvements on said lots

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of mortgage dated July 23rd 1902 and recorded July 26th 1902 at 8 am at Muskogee Ind. Ter. (filed only) of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by Grace L. Lynch & R. E. Lynch her husband conveying said real estate to C. W. Knickerbocker to secure the pay-

ment of certain notes therein named, the same having been fully paid.
