KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT The Lawrence County Bank of Puer City, State of Missouri

for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by Jessie L. Brown and Jennie Forsythe do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Jessie L. Brown and Jennie Forsythe and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in

the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

One brick store building fifty feet front by one hundred feet deep in Block 96 on West side of Main Street containing two store rooms below and office and half above known as the Forsythe Building and situate in the County of Tulsa Indian Territory.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of mortgage dated October 12<sup>th</sup> 1901 and recorded October 18<sup>th</sup> 1901 in Book D at Page 272 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by Jessie L. Brown and Jennie Forsythe conveying said real estate to The said Lawrence County Bank to secure the payment of a certain \$6000.00 therein named, the same having been fully paid.
