for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by *J H Boyd* the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged *J H Boyd*
do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said *J H Boyd*

and unto *his* heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in

^{25"} the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: *25 x 100 feet bounded as follows: Beginning sixty five feet west of the north east corner of Lot One, Block 106 on the street line; thence running southerly parallel with the street or alley line 100 feet thence running westerly parallel with the street line 25 feet thence running northerly parallel with street or alley line 100 feet to place of beginning, being a part of Lot 1, Block 106 in the town of Tulsa, I.T.*

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of mortgage dated *October 21 1905* and recorded *October 21 1905* in Book *2* at Page *466* of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by

J H Boyd conveying said real estate to *E C Francis Executor* to secure the payment of *one* certain *note* therein named, the same having been fully paid.
