N. R. R. in Tulsa Indian Territory

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated *Sept 29 - 1906*

and recorded *Sept 29 1906* in Book *3* at Page *65* of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by
