KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT

L. K. Cone and Edith M. Cone his wife

for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by A. A. Knox, H. L. Reed and Minnie Reed his wife do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said A. A. Knox, H. L. Reed and Minnie Reed his wife and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in

the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The south 22 feet of Lot 4 all of Lot 5, north 15 feet of Lot 6 and part of Lot 14, described as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 14 in Block 11; thence running northeasterly along line between lots 14 and 15, 136.7 feet; thence southeasterly along line between lots 6 and 14, 15 feet; thence southeasterly parallel to and 85 feet distance from line between lots 13 and 14 to block line; thence along block line to place of beginning. Part of Lot 15 Block 11 described to-wit: Beginning at the southeast corner of Lot 15 in Block 11; thence running northeasterly along line between lots 14 and 15, 136.7 feet; thence northeasterly along line between lots 4 and 5 and 15, 122 feet; thence southeasterly parallel to and 122 feet from line between lots 14 and 15 to block line thence south along said block line to place of beginning in North Tulsa Indian Territory.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated November 13th 1905 and recorded March 26th 1906 in Book 12 at Page 37 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by
