KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT George Bullette of Tulsa, Ind. Ter.for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by Ed. Chastaindo hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Ed. Chastainand unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in

the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Beginning at the southeast corner of Lot Two and running north one hundred and fifty feet, thence west fifty feet, thence south one hundred and fifty feet, thence east fifty feet to the place of beginning, all in Block Thirty (the north fifty feet being in Lot One) and according to the official Plat & Post survey of the City of Tulsa, Ind. Ter.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Trust dated July 12th 1906 and recorded July 13 1906 in Book 3 at Page 11 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by

Geo. Bullette conveying said real estate to Ed. Chastain to secure the payment of three certain notes therein named, the same having been fully paid.
