

DEED OF RELEASE.



KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT I

John Dermott

for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by Chauncey A. Owens

do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Chauncey A. Owens

and unto his

heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in

the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to wit: Beginning at N.E. corner of Lot 8 (Eight) Block 60 Tulsa Indian Territory, thence in a S.W. direction a distance of 47 feet to N.E. corner of Lot 7 said Block 60, thence in a S.E. direction along lot line between Lots 7 and 8 a distance of 90 feet to S.E. corner of Lot 7, thence in a N.E. direction 47 feet to alley in said Block 60, thence in a N.W. direction 90 feet to place of beginning on a line parallel to and 47 feet from lot line between Lots 7 and 8 said tract having a frontage of 47 feet on West 20th Street and a depth 490 feet with a uniform width of 47 feet.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Chauncey A. Owens dated 9-19
