

## DEED OF RELEASE.

THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA, BY NOTARY PUBLIC:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN

and O.C. Stone a single man do hereby grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said

and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in  
town of North Tulsa Cherokee Nation Ind Ter.  
the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to wit: Beginning at the southeast corner of Lot Two (2) in Block  
Twenty two (22), running thence in a northwesterly direction along 5th Street Avenue 28.6 feet  
thence in a westerly direction 60 feet to the Creek Cherokee line, thence due east along  
the said line to place of beginning, also parts of lots 1 and 2 in Block 22 in the town of  
Tulsa Creek Nation described as follows: Beginning at a point on the west line of lot  
34 feet south of the northwest corner of said lot, thence in an easterly direction 80  
feet to the Creek Cherokee line; thence due east to the west corner of lot 2, thence  
in a southerly direction to the southeast corner of lot 2, thence in a westerly  
direction along the north line of North 3rd Street, 70 feet, thence in a  
northerly direction at right angles 50 feet thence west at right angles 70 feet  
to the westerly thence in a northerly direction along the alley to place of
