

DEED OF RELEASE.

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT

I Sallie E. Gray of Missouri

for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by Arthur J. Stone receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Arthur J. Stone and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in

the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

The west fifty (50) feet of Lot three (3), and the west fifty (50) feet of Lot two (2), and the west fifty (50) feet of the south ten (10) feet of Lot one (1) Block seventy-five (75) in the town of Tulsa Creek nation Western District Indian Territory according to the government survey of plat of the aforesaid town.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of mortgage dated October 5th 1906 and recorded October 20th 1906 in Book 2 at Page 125 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by

Arthur J. Stone and his wife Maria Stone conveying said real estate to

Sallie E. Gray to secure the payment of certain promissory note therein named, the same having been fully paid.
