do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Virginia Rea Ott and Phil E Ott  
and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in  
the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of lot two (2) in Block one hundred and thirty four (34) in the Original town of Tulsa Creek Nation Indian Territory according to the original plat of the town of Tulsa as approved by the Secretary of the Interior April 11, 1902

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of mortgage dated December 10, 1906  
and recorded December 22, 1906 in Book 3 at Page 115 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by  
Virginia Rea Ott and J. Slater Davidson husband and Phil E Ott conveying said real estate to  
J. Slater Davidson to secure the pay-  
ment of the certain notes therein named, the same having been fully paid.
