for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by Creamney Willison and Joseph H. Willison
do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Creamney Willison and Joseph H. Willison and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot one (1), in Block sixteen (16), of the Cherokee Heights Addition to Tulsa Indian Territory, said addition being located on the south one-half of the south-east quarter of Section thirty one (31), Township twenty-two north Range thirteen (13) east

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of mortgage dated 23^d day of July 1907 and recorded July 23^d 1907 in Book 20 at Page 117 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by Creamney Willison & Joseph H. Willison conveying said real estate to The Cherokee Company to secure the payment of — certain — note therein named, the same having been fully paid.
