the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
The north half of Lot Two and the south twenty-five feet of
Lot One Block One hundred sixty-six, in the City of Tulsa,
Western District of Indian Territory, according to the U.S. Survey
and Plat thereof.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of *Mortgage* dated *August 1st* 190*7*
and recorded *October 24* 190*7* in Book *L* at Page *318* of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by
