KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT P. E. Coyne, a single man,

for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by Rachel C. Brady and W. J. Brady
wife and husband do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Rachel C. Brady and W. J.
Brady and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in
the 28th Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot Eight Block Sixty in Tulsa, I. T. according to
the official plat and survey thereof thence in a southeasterly direction forty-
seven feet to the northeast corner of Lot Seven in said Block Sixty thence in a
southeasterly direction along Lot line between Lots seven and eight ninety feet to
southeast corner of Lot seven thence in a northeasterly direction forty-seven
feet to alley in said Block thence in a northeasterly direction ninety feet to place
of beginning, or as straight line parallel to and forty-seven feet from the
lot line between Lots seven and eight said tract of ground having a frontage of
forty-seven feet on the "A" street and a depth of ninety feet with a
uniform width of forty-seven feet.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated March 15th 1906
and recorded March 26th 1906 in Book L at Page 538 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by
Rachel C. Brady and W. J. Brady conveying said real estate to
P. E. Coyne to secure the pay-
ment of one certain promissory note therein named, the same having been fully paid.
