 do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said R. E. Lynch and G. P.
 Lynch, and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in
 the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

 Lots four-five-six-seven-Eight-and Nine, in Block-four-
 teen (14) and all improvements thereon said Lots constitute a
 block 300 x 300 feet square, and are located in North Lusk
 Indian Territory, according to the Government survey
 and Plat thereof.

 This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated January 13th 1905
 and recorded January 16th 1905 in Book L at Page 349 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by
 R. E. Lynch and G. P. Lynch conveying said real estate to
