his wife do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said *Loren Conaway and*
Ida Conaway his wife their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in
the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The south fifty feet of Lot five and the north
Twenty-five feet of Lot four in Block one
hundred seventy-five in the City of Tulsa,
Western District of Indian Territory, according
to the U.S. Survey and plat thereof.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of *mortgage* dated *August 12* 190*4*
and recorded *Aug. 3, 1904* in Book *L* at Page *299* of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by
Loren Conaway and Ida Conaway his wife conveying said real estate to
Katherine J. Molitor to secure the pay-
ment of *one* certain *Note* therein named, the same having been fully paid.
