KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT we Henry W. Perryman, Guardian and D. M. Martindale Trustee  
for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by Minna Wilhelm of  
Tulsa, I. T. do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Minna  
Wilhelm and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in  
the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South one half (1/2) of Lot Three (3) in Block One  
Hundred Eighty four (184) in the Town of Tulsa, Western District,  
Indian Territory except a part of said south half of lot  
Three (3) in the western end thereof forty feet wide leaving a  
tract fifty by one hundred feet at the south east corner of  
said Lot Three (3)

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Trust dated September, first, 1907  
and recorded September 26, 1907 in Book 20 at Page 279 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by  
Minna Wilhelm and Fred Wilhelm, her husband conveying said real estate to  
D. M. Martindale Trustee to secure the pay-  
ment of one certain promissory note therein named, the same having been fully paid.
