DEED OF RELEASE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT

C. D. Boggesshall

for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by Charles H. Hatcher and Wife
 Ida V. Hatcher do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Charles H. Hatcher
 and Wife Ida V. Hatcher and unto Their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in
 the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: Part of Lots Four (4) and Five (5) in Block One
 Hundred Five (105) in the City of Tulsa,

described as follows to-wit: Beginning at the Southwesterly corner
 of Lot Five (5) in Block One Hundred Five (105) and thence in a northerly
 direction along the Easterly line of Main Street a distance of Seventeen (17)
 feet; thence in an Easterly direction and parallel with the Southerly
 line of Lot Five (5) a distance of One Hundred Forty (140) feet more or less
 to the alley line; thence in a Southerly direction along the
 alley line a distance of Twenty and one half (20 1/2); thence in a
 Westerly direction and parallel with the Northerly line hereof a distance
 of One Hundred Forty (140) feet more or less to Main Street; thence
 Northerly along the Easterly line of Main Street three and one-
 half (3 1/2) feet to the place of beginning.
