The South Fifty (50) Feet of Lot Four (4) in Block One Hundred and Fifty Five (155) in Lissa, Creek Nation, Indian Territory

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated September 14th, 1905 and recorded September 16th, 1905 in Book L at Page 442 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by Benjamin F. Moore & Wife Lillie Moore conveying said real estate to J. J. or Lena Angersbach to secure the payment of Their certain Notes therein named, the same having been fully paid.
