This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of mortgage dated November 12th 1907 and recorded November 15th 1907 in Book - at Page - of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by John J. Blair and belia Blair his wife conveying said real estate to Sallie E. Gray to secure the payment of their certain promissory note therein named, the same having been fully paid.
