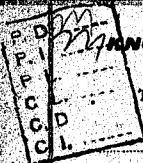


## DEED OF RELEASE.



KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT J. A. Friend

for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by Minnie Anderson receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Minnie Anderson and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in

the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

A plat of ground 50 by 95 feet, more fully described as follows: commencing at the southeast corner of Lot four (4) in Block eight (8) and running northerly parallel with the alley thirty (30) feet to second street thence easterly along and parallel to said street a distance of 95 feet; thence northerly 50 feet, with second street a distance of 50 feet to the place of beginning all in Block 84 in the City of Tulsa Oklahoma.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of mortgage dated June 4<sup>th</sup> 1907 and recorded June 17<sup>th</sup> 1907 in Book 3 at Page 295 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by Minnie Anderson conveying said real estate to J. A. Friend to secure the payment of one certain note therein named, the same having been fully paid.
