KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT E. A. Lilly

for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by Joseph J. Shockey and S. J. Shockey husband and wife, do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Joseph J. and S. J. Shockey and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in 28" the Eight Recording District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

The South East quarter of the South West quarter (SE 1/4 of SW 1/4) and the North West quarter of the South West quarter (NW 1/4 of SW 1/4) of South East quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 11 (5) Township Twenty (20) North, Range Thirteen (13) East.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated January 30 1907 and recorded February 4 1907 in Book 12 at Page 199 of the records of the 28" Recording District of the Indian Territory, by Joseph J. + S. J. Shockey conveying said real estate to E. A. Lilly to secure the payment of one certain promissory note therein named, the same having been fully paid.
