

DEED OF RELEASE.



KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT James H. Kibb

for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by Stan J. Davison and wife Mae Davison do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Stan J. Davison and wife Mae Davison and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

All of Lot three (3) in Block two (2) in Lindsay Addition to Tulsa Creek National Indian Territory.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of mortgage dated July 21st, 1905 and recorded July 24th, 1905 in Book 5 at Page 422 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by Stan J. Davison & M. Mae Davison his wife conveying said real estate to James H. Kibb to secure the payment of their certain note therein named, the same having been fully paid.
