the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of Lot one in Block two in Tulsa  
Oklahoma according to the recorded plat thereof.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Trust dated October 17<sup>th</sup> 1907  
and recorded Oct 19<sup>th</sup> 1907 in Book 21 at Page 407 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by  
George West conveying said real estate to  
O. G. Ferguson to secure the pay-  
ment of one certain promissory note therein named, the same having been fully paid.
