approved government plat of the town of Tulsa, Creek Nation, Western District, Indian Territory.

and recorded Jan 12 1906 in Book L at Page 503 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by
A. J. Stone and W. R. Ritchie conveying said real estate to
